The SSLC System at Warwick

Within each academic department there is a committee made up of at least two directly elected student representatives from each year group and at least two staff members as a general rule. SSLC's exist to provide a forum for both staff and students to discuss and resolve academic related issues.

The Faculty Rep

As the title suggests, the Medical Faculty Representative represents all of the students in the Medical Faculty. He/she oversees the running of the SSLC's in their Faculty making sure they are aware of any issues that are coming up at these meetings and feeding them back to the Students' Union and the University.

They attend the Medical Faculty Board Committee meetings, this isn't as daunting as it sounds! These committees meet only once per term and they are a good way of having a direct say in the running of your degree and those of the students you represent and making a real difference.

Also, the Faculty Representative is a member of both the Students' Union Academic Forum and of Union Council. This is a chance to meet other student reps and discuss any problems your Faculty is having and get help as well as having a say on Union policy in general.

Election of the Medical Faculty Representative take place in September, **nominations close on Friday 16th September at 9.00pm and voting takes place online from Tuesday 20th September to Thursday 22nd September.**
