

## Mixed Netball Leagues 2007- 2008

### **1.Organisation**

The League is organised and run by the Student Sports Committee. The League has a nominated representative to run the league, the representative shall be considered as the organiser and the Student Sports Committee will have the final say on all matters of the league.

### **2.Squads**

- a. All players must be members of Warwick Sport.
- b. The Squad may consist of up to fifteen players and must be of mixed sex.
- c. At least five players must be present in order to play a match.
- d. The team playing on court must, at any one time consist of at least two players from either sex.
- e. Players who wish to play for more than one team must register with both teams and is up to the player's discretion who they play for should the two teams play together.
- f. A points system will operate to restrict the number of University of Warwick Women netball players on court at any one time. First team players regarded as 4 points, second team players as 3 points, third team players as 2 points and fourth as 1 point. A maximum of 9 points may be reached.

### **3. General Rule**

- a. The standard rules of the All England Netball Association.
- b. 3 points shall be awarded for a win, 1 for a draw.
- a. A team forfeits a game if they fail to turn up to play.
- b. The game shall also be forfeited if the team breaks any of the rules in section 2 above.
- c. Teams unable to fulfill a fixture must give notice at least two days in advance, to both the League organizer and the opposing team's captain, in order to avoid incurring the above penalties.

### **4. Fixtures**

- a. Fixtures will be placed on Warwick Sport website ([www.warwick sport.co.uk/leagues](http://www.warwick sport.co.uk/leagues)) as soon as is possible. Teams are asked to consult this website several times a week.
- b. If a team cannot make a fixture they must inform the organisers as soon as possible and at least two days before the match. If teams pull out of fixtures without adequate notice then the match may be forfeited to the opposition (rule 3b and d apply)
- c. The date, time and location of fixture can only be changed with the permission of the League organiser.
- d. Teams should provide match balls. If not possible, they should be obtained from the Westwood Games Hall in advance of play.

### **5.League Position**

Teams shall be split in to pools. League position shall be decided upon

- i) Points obtained
- ii) Matches won
- iii) Goal difference

### **6. Disputes**

Disputes shall be put to the League organiser and resolved, as the Student Sports Committee considers appropriate.

## **7. Results**

Match results should be entered on the league web pages by both team captains. This should be done within 48 hours of the game taking place. Failure to meet this deadline will result in the result of the match taken as void.

## **8. Conduct**

Should a team, or players from a team, indulge in any actions that are deemed by the organisers to be detrimental to the good spirit of the league, then the organisers are entitled to take whatever action is deemed appropriate. This may include, but is not limited to, suspension of players, loss of points or exclusion from the competition. Such penalties are subject to the approval of the Student Sports Committee whose decision is final.
